

STANDING OUT WHY ARE WE DIFFERENT?



Gerontologist Leonard Hayflick at the University of California thinks that humans have a definite expiry date.

In 1961, he showed that human skin cells grown under laboratory conditions tend to divide approximately 50 times before becoming senescent, which means no longer able to divide.





Psalm 139: 13-16
